SUMMARY & WHAT TO BRING

Upon successful completion of the 2 day course, you will be awarded with a certificate of completion by the 'Cambridge Dog Training School'. Students are recommended to bring their own dog to work on (aggressive & 'hard to train' dogs are welcome). **Day 1 will be 'classroom theory' & Day 2 will be 'practical sessions with dogs'**. Day 2 will take place outdoors, please dress accordingly. You should also bring: dog treats, food for your dog, favourite toys, collars and leads.

Your dog must be comfortable in his/her own crate for up to 2 hrs at a time. After you have paid and booked online, you will be sent a form about your dog(s) by email to complete. Approx. 12 students per course.

Attendees can bring photo cameras, notepads and voice recorders for personal use only. **Strictly no video recording without prior consent.**

We strongly suggest that you read and understand our standard terms & conditions.

- If you want to book a place in our course, please make sure you clearly check the dates and times of the course. You need to pay the full fee to ensure your registration is complete for the course you want to go to. Any payments or balances paid to G3 Dogs are strictly non-refundable and not transferable to a later course. No exceptions.
- We accept payments via PayPal as it is one of the safest and most secure ways to pay online. You can make payments directly to training@g3dogs.com if you have a PayPal account, or if you don't, you can also pay securely online via PayPal with most UK credit/debit cards.
- Unfortunately, we cannot accept cheques or postal orders unless arranged in advance with our staff – please request an invoice by emailing: training@g3dogs.com. Please do **not** send any payments by post unless instructed.
- The full balance of the course is due prior to the course date. All balance payments are non refundable.
- A student may not change the date of their chosen course and fees are non-refundable & non-transferable to other courses.
